

HEALTHY SMALL CHURCH

On October 22nd, Grace and United Faith Presbyterian Churches co-hosted a one-day workshop presented by Dr. Dennis Bickers titled The Healthy Small Church. The \$20 Registration fee covered one copy of the book he wrote with the same title and lunch. Dennis, as he prefers to be called, was a bi-vocational pastor for 20 years in a small church in southern Indiana. It was wonderful to hear a small church pastor speaking to members and pastors of small churches. His presentation, filled with humor and truth, lifted up the importance of the small membership church and the involve-



ment of the members. He reminded us that approximately two-thirds of all churches in the United States average 100 people or fewer on Sundays. More than 100,000 churches average 50 people or fewer in their Sunday morning attendance. Thank you to everyone who worked to make this event such a success.

WHITEWATER VALLEY PRESBYTERY MEETING



Grace and United Faith Presbyterian Churches co-hosted the November Presbytery meeting. Highlights of the meeting:

Election of the new vice-moderator of Presbytery Rev. Youngsoo An. Rev. An is the first Asian pastor to serve in this capacity in Whitewater Valley.

An All Saint's Day Worship Service, planned and conducted by the Fort Wayne Pastors: Rev. Jeff Lehn, Rev. Youngsoo An, Rev. Laura Sherwood, Rev. Kathleen O'Connell, and Rev. Ann Pitman. Worship included an interactive meditation by Rev. Kathleen O'Connell titled "Table Stories;" installation of our newly elected Moderator

John Paulson, CRE, and Vice-Moderator Rev. Youngsoo An by former moderator Ginny Sheets, and EP, Rev. Alan Thames; the reading of the 2015 Necrology Report which was preceded by a prayer written by Rev. Arianne Lehn; communion, and lighting of candles in memory of those who no longer gather at our Tables, but are present in our hearts. An offering designated for the Christmas Joy Offering was received during worship which totaled \$884. Prelude and Postlude were played by Bob Bausser on the bagpipes. Day of Caring Success stories were shared. Attendees of "The Healthy Small Church" workshop shared some of their learnings from the day and then invited those present to consider how the learnings might apply to their congregations. Presbytery meetings are adjourned with the use of the Halverson Benediction which states:

You go nowhere by accident. Wherever you go, God is sending you.

Wherever you are, God has put you there.

God has a purpose in your being there.

Christ who indwells you has something he wants to do through you, where you are.

Believe this and go in His Spirit's grace and love and power.



NEW SIGNS AT GRACE!

If you have not noticed, we now have large (12") numbers at each of the entrances to Grace's building. They begin with the Ramp entrance which is #1 and work clockwise around the building: #2 is the Scout entrance, #3 is the Tower entrance, #4 is the Office entrance, #5 is the West parking lot entrance across from the Manse, and #6 is the Huffman Street entrance. This follows the preferred method for the Fire department. So, in the event of an emergency you can now give the door number to assist EMT or police in knowing where to enter. This will also be a major help when the pastor is meeting someone in the evening to know where to tell them to come for the meeting.



INTERIOR DIRECTIONAL SIGNAGE

You will also notice new interior directional signage. We had hoped to have them sooner, but we did get them – just in time – for the presbytery meeting. They were taped up temporarily (due to still having wet paint!) for the presbytery meeting. They were then permanently attached after the meeting. These directional signs should assist new people coming into the building. Along with the directional signage, we now have uniform signage above all the doors of the building; Classrooms (now numbered 1-3), Nursery, Upper Room, Conference Room, etc..
