Pastor's Ponderings

Thank you so much for being so understanding about my recent trips. The opportunity to travel in Israel, Palestine, and Turkey with just two other people was amazing. A small group makes such a difference. We were able to travel in regular sized cars which allowed us to see places we could not get to in a large bus or when traveling with a large group. I saw many places I had not seen before such as the Church of the Annunciation in Nazareth, Hebron, Nablus & Jacob's Well. We were guests in people's homes. In Bethlehem we ate with Zougbi Zougbi & his son and daughter. In Ibillin, we were quests in the home of Abuna Chacour, the retired Archbishop of Galilee. (His cook was wearing an apron that said: "Have you hugged a Presbyterian Today?"

). We had dinner with three members of the Bereaved Parents Committee, one Palestinian couple, and one Israeli. Each member of the committee has lost a child due to the "conflict." (They are searching for ways to live together in peace and have become close friends.)

I have been asked to speak about my trip to the Holy Land on Presby-Day, June 15, at First Pres. We are looking at dates in June when I can share more about my trip here at Grace for those who do not attend Presby-Day.

Though my son, Paul, is not a soloist, there is definitely something about being able to say, "I saw my son sing in Carnegie Hall." He sings with the St. Louis Symphony Choir. The STL Symphony and Choir had been especially asked to sing the Carnegie Hall debut performance of "The Gospel According to the Other Mary," in celebration of the composer's 70th birthday year. My son described it as "Interesting" and "a little Bizarre." That pretty well sums it up! My cousin, Jackie, my daughter, Kimberlee, and I were glad we went even though it poured down rain the entire day we were in NYC.
