

Many people see the terms heritage and legacy as almost the same and use the terms interchangeably. But there is a very subtle difference in their meanings. For some, a heritage is something that has been handed down from previous generation(s); while a legacy is something that is being handed down to succeeding generations. In this sense one generation's legacy becomes the next generation's heritage.

Both terms can refer to tangible things (possessions, property, money), or to the intangible (personal characteristics, outlook on life, talent in the arts). As summer at Grace winds down and fall begins, expect to hear more about these closely-related terms.


