#### THOUGHTS FROM PASTOR ROB

This month we had a lot - A LOT - to fill our newsletter and I had nothing important to say, so instead of me saying nothing we have an article for you from Jim about Stewardship and what God has given us.

The Stewardship Committee has been meeting and has begun to explore what it means for a disciple of Christ to be a steward. We've learned that a steward is a person who manages someone else's property or affairs, just as the owner would manage them herself/himself.

The Psalmist declares that "The earth is the LORD's and everything in it..." In fact, at no time do we ever read of God relinquishing ownership of anything that he set in motion. This gives a clear view to us stewards of the owner we're serving.

But why would an all-knowing and all-powerful God entrust us with any of his stuff? Stewardship is the path God uses to make us into the people he wants us to be. Our obedience and intentional stewardship of what God gives us (time, talent, treasure), provides us with an opportunity to vividly reflect his image that we bear. Indeed, our discipleship and stewardship are two sides of the same coin. Discipleship is our calling; stewardship is our responsibility.

For the Church, the term *stewardship* has become synonymous with giving, fundraising, or capital campaigns. While stewardship certainly includes these, it also includes such important responsibilities as conservation of the planet on which we reside and supporting issues of social justice. We should also include the Gospel message and the relationships we have with others. Undoubtedly, each of you could name more.

As the Stewardship Committee explores more of what being a steward entails, you can expect to hear from us again.

#### **Scoutmaster Bob's Chili**

#### Ingredients (stuff needed):

1/4 cup olive oil

4 large onions, chopped

2 lbs of hot pork sausage (I like Tennessee Pride)

2 lbs of 95% ground beef

1/3 cup chili powder

3 Tbs cumin

2 cans beef broth

2 large cans of hot chili beans with chilies

3 Tbs oregano

3 Tbs cocoa powder

2 Tbs cinnamon powder

2 tsp cayenne powder

4 cups tomato juice

1 can of crushed tomatoes (I like Rotel)

8 cloves garlic, freshly and finely chopped

Mix chili powder, cumin, oregano, cocoa powder, cinnamon, cayenne pepper, in a bowl. Set aside for later.

In a large skillet, sauté onions in most of the olive oil.

In a #14 Dutch Oven, (or stockpot at home), add the rest of the olive oil and brown pork sausage and ground beef. Season with around 2 tsp Kosher (Sea) salt. Cook for around 20 minutes.

Add onion mixture to beef and stir in spices. Add garlic and Cook around 5 minutes.

Add tomato juice, tomatoes, and beef stock. Bring to a boil, lower heat to simmer.

Add Chili beans and simmer for around an hour.

For additional kick, substitute hot chili beans for cans without the chilies, then add freshly chopped jalapeno (2) and Habanero pepper to taste.
