Scrip Info

Scrip is a fundraising program that works while you shop. Scrip turns everyday shopping into cash for the Church when families use gift cards to pay for everyday purchases (like gas and groceries) instead of using the regular credit/debit card or money. Scrip is gift cards from national and local retailers. They're the same gift cards that you buy at the store. Many popular retailers partipating in or Scrip program include: Kohl's, Bath & Body Works, Meijer, Wendy's, and many, MANY others.

Here's how it works: Participating retailers agree to sell gift cards to Great Lakes Scrip Centers at a discount. Member families like yours buy and redeem the certificate for full value. The difference between the full value and the discount is donated to Grace as fundraising income.

So why not earn money for our church without spending a single additional penny? Just spend your regular shopping dollars with Scrip. The number of retailers participating is ENDLESS!

32% funds raised go to Presbyterian Disaster Assistance :

Works alongside communities as they recover and find hope

after the devastation of natural or human-caused disasters, and support for refugees

36% funds raised go to Presbyterian Hunger Program :

Takes action to alleviate hunger, care for creation,

and the systemic causes of poverty so all may be fed

32% funds raised go to Self-Development of People :

Invests in communities responding to their experiences of oppression, poverty, and injustice and educates Presbyterians about the impact of these issues
